## Rules for both days and all events

- Entry fees for Benefit and Ironwood Events Center Horse Show classes \$25 per class for pre-entries RECEIVED by <u>Wednesday, Oct. 14, by 5 p.m</u>. Benefit and Ironwood show classes are \$35 after Oct. 14. Schooling rounds are available at \$25 each.
  - Pre-entries may be dropped off at Ironwood Events Center, 5600 Whiskey Springs Rd., Reno, 89510 OR

- Class 204 entry fee is \$100 per rider. Please fill out separate Challenge Cup registration form.
- Class 205 entry fee is \$50 per rider. Please fill out separate Speed Derby registration form.
- There is a \$5 per horse fee for required by SNHSA when participating in each venue. Please fill out separate registration forms for participation in both the Benefit show or the Ironwood Events Center Horse Show.
- Non-member fee of \$20 for riders competing in either venue.
- Riders must be SNHSA members to enter the SNHSA Challenge Cup and/or Speed Derby.
- Please bring your own food for lunch.
- Stabling is available at Ironwood Events Center: \$20 open day pen, \$25 for temporary stall, and \$30 for barn/shed row stall. Call ahead to reserve a stall: Sue Davis at 775-475-0100.
- Thursday or Friday Schooling is available at \$25/horse. Call or text show manager the time you plan to arrive.
- SNHSA requires that dogs be on a leash at all sanctioned events. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors.
- All cross-entry rules apply for classes entered at each show venue. Please refer to the Rule Book available online at www.SNHSA.org for a complete set of rules.
- For the welfare of the horse, horses/ponies may not enter or show in more than 6 classes a day.
- At least FOUR classes per Hunter division MUST RUN and there must be a minimum of THREE horse/rider combinations per division for a Division Award. Division awards are offered by Ironwood Events Center, and will be awarded to Hunter and Equitation divisions only.

#### **COVID-19 Precautions:**

- Trainers are asked to bring their riders' payment, along with pre and post registration forms to the Office.
  - Credit card payments are acceptable with 3% fee added
  - Number will not be given to anyone without signed, open check, cash or Credit card information.
- Bring your own water
- Masks are required anytime while indoors & outdoors; maintain 6' distance from others
- When mounted, riders not required to wear a mask, and will not be penalized if one is worn while competing.
- You may not enter the grounds if you have:
  - o A fever of or above 99.5 (take your temperature at home the morning of the show to confirm no fever)
  - Been exposed to anyone who tested positive for COVID-19 within last 2 weeks
  - COVID-19 symptoms (subjective or measured fever, cough, shortness of breath and/or difficulty breathing, sore throat, muscle pain, headache, chills/shaking, or newly developed loss of taste or smell)
  - Tested positive for COVID-19 within last 2 weeks; have negative test since the positive test
- Each horse is limited to 3 people on the competition grounds (rider, trainer and a parent or groom)
- Spectators not directly connected to a horse are not allowed on competition grounds.
- Please do not congregate in warm-up arenas or back gate areas.
- When learning courses, please take a photo of the course and move away to maintain 6' social distance.
