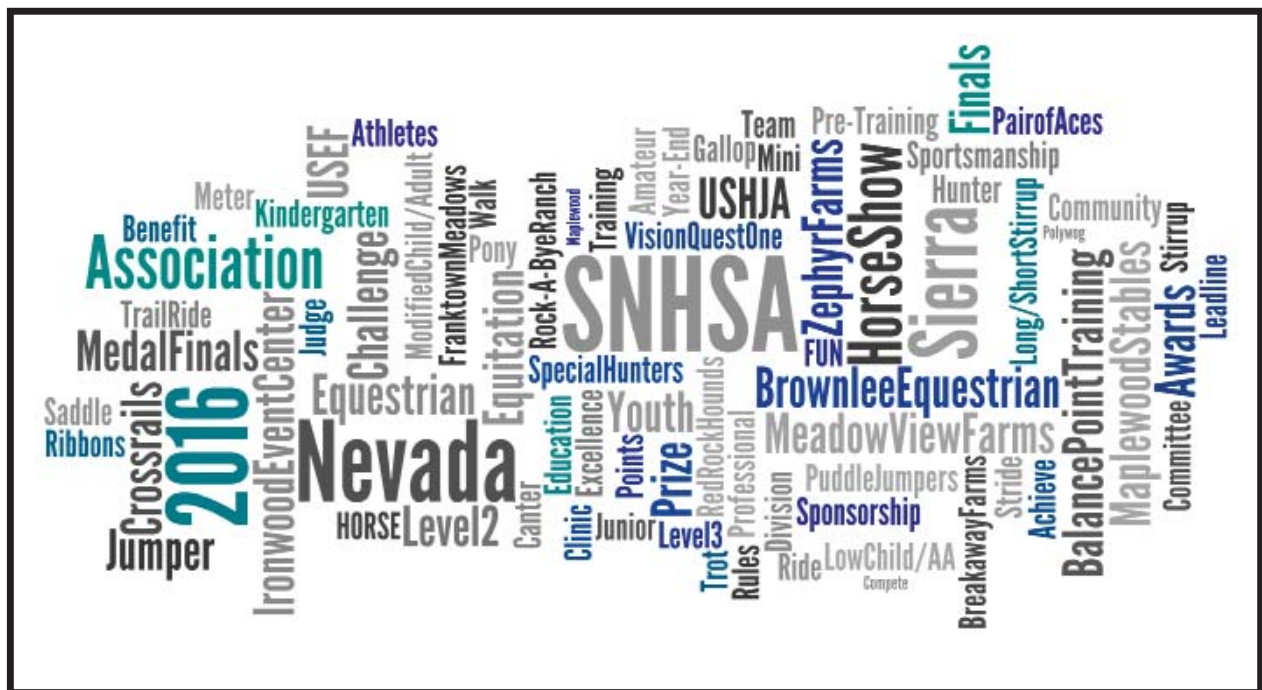

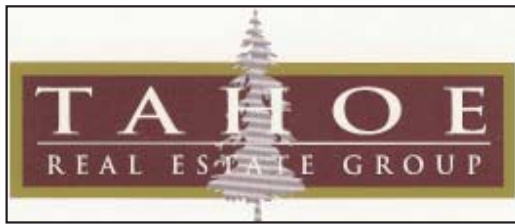

What is SNHSA Youth Committee?

The Mission of the SNHSA Youth Committee is “to promote good horsemanship, further education and to be actively involved in SNHSA Hunter-Jumper shows.” The goal of the Committee is to offer junior members a constructive opportunity to participate in SNHSA’s mission and to make a difference in the local horse community.

This committee is open to all SNHSA members under the age of 18. We meet at least once a month for at least one hour. The Committee’s members shape all goals and responsibilities of the Committee.

All committed Youth Committee members are eligible for volunteer service hour credits. Furthermore, this would be a great activity to put on any school resume. It is our hope that every barn be represented in the Committee so that every barn will have a voice in the Committee’s activities and endeavors.

Responsibilities and Requirements

The Youth Committee is looking for dedicated SNHSA members who are looking to make a positive impact in both their riding and “every day” community. It is not too late to sign up as a member!

- **Requirements:** must be a current member of SNHSA in good standing and under the age of 18.
- **Responsibilities:** Attend monthly meetings, Chair at least one Youth Committee sanctioned program, complete a minimum of 30 hours of volunteer service per show season (12 months) in the support of approved SNHSA events and projects.
 - Members who have completed or are on schedule to complete the required hours are eligible to participate in various SNHSA programs for a discounted price.

USHJA Affiliate Excellence in Equitation Awards

SNHSA promotes “Excellence in Equitation” by recognizing the accomplishments of riders competing at SNHSA-sanctioned equitation competitions. Awards are given to the top 10 junior and amateur riders based on cumulative competition-year points earned in SNHSA-sanctioned equitation divisions.

Riders must have USHJA/USEF active memberships to be eligible to participate in this program. Membership information must be provided to SNHSA prior to the end of the event for points to count. SNHSA three-venue and 10-point rules are applicable.

SNHSA Middle and High School Challenge

As a sport often not recognized within the traditional school system, SNHSA aims to fill this gap by acknowledging the dedication and hard work junior riders exhibit to both their school peers and their “horse” community.

School teams accrue points by competing in a best middle/high school rider class offered at all SNHSA-sanctioned competitions and completing a horsemanship test. The school team with the most points wins. Junior riders must be in the 7th through 12th grades and SNHSA members of good standing to be eligible to participate in the challenge. Junior riders of the top ranking middle and high school must be present at the Year-End Awards event in order to receive their awards.

The Sierra Nevada Horse Show Association's (SNHSA) Academic Excellence Award and Honor Society recognizes outstanding high school and middle school students. More than just an honor roll, SNHSA serves to honor those students who have demonstrated excellence in the areas of scholarship, leadership, service, and character. These characteristics have been associated with membership in the organization.

Honor Society
