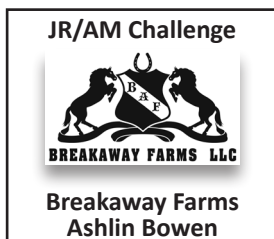
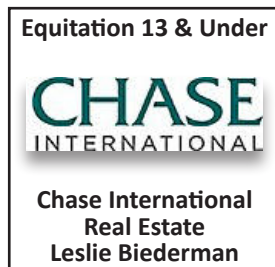

## 2019 Member Education and Junior Ambassadors Program

This year, our Junior Ambassadors participated in an educational series of clinics put on by **Good to Know Horses**, a non-profit organization associated with Maplewood Stables. Their mission is to help people improve their horsemanship skills and understanding of the horse.

The participants learned about course design strategies, proper biting, conformation and judging. This was the first year we, as an organization, hosted this type of learning series for our youth. In total, 11 of our outstanding junior riders participated in not only the clinics, but the educational volunteer hours for the non-profit, Good To Know Horses. At the end of the series, six exceptional juniors completed the clinics, volunteer hours and a series of exams and were awarded a spot in the annual SNHSA education clinic with Bernie Taurig. These spots were sponsored by SNHSA and Julie Winkle.

Our Junior riders learned an incredible amount of useful knowledge in this clinic series and we, as an organization, are proud to bring to life our mission statement to provide a forum representing the best interest of horses, exhibitors and our equestrian community as a whole in SNHSA equestrian competitions and educational opportunities. Our top six participants, in no particular order, are as follows **Hailey Childers, Cadence Lacroix, Niya Kuhns, Jolie Paddock, Katie Caldwell and Jenna McAmis**. We are looking forward to continuing and expanding this program in the 2020 season.

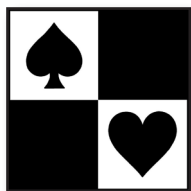

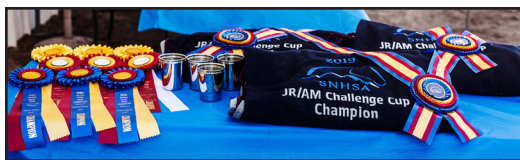

# 2019 SNHSA Pro/JR-AM Speed Derby

An inaugural event, the **SNHSA Pro/JR-AM Speed Derby**, took place Sunday, Aug. 25, at **Brownlee Equestrian**.

The derby is a team speed round competition with teams consisting of two riders, a professional and either a junior or adult amateur rider. Both riders must be SNHSA members in good standing. Coordinating team attire is encouraged for each team.

Four teams competed in the Derby, following the Challenge Cup event and the winning team received embroidered saddle pads, and rider sash ribbons along with first place ribbons.

The **first place team was Bonnie & Clyde, Christina Cacciao on Trip the Wire, and Annelise Appleseth on Evening Star.**

Reserve champions were Gen Eq: Cadence Lacroix on Denim and Liz Lacroix on Derringer

The **3rd place team was What's a Half Halt? with Ally Smit on Pot of Gold and Liz Reader on Fashionably Late.**

The **4th place team was The B Boys, with Jenna McAmis on Allegro BF and Liz Reader on Anything But Ordinary.**

The class is run as a speed class under Table III with faults converted to seconds. The first rider starts the clock as they cross the start line, and the second rider stops the clock as they cross the finish line. For each rail down, 4 seconds is added to the team's overall time. There is no penalty for refusals other than the time taken, but the team will be eliminated if any single horse has two refusals.

The course consists of 16 fences, with each jumping eight fences. The Junior or Adult Amateur rider rides first, with fences set at the 2'6" height. The professional rider rides second, with their fence height at 3'0".

The second rider will wait in a marked area while the first rider completes their section of the course. Once the first rider has completed their course, they cross a line and the second rider leaves the marked area to complete their section of the course. A 4-second time penalty is added to the team's overall time if they start too soon. Team prizes are awarded ribbons through 8th place.
