## **2023 USHJA Outreach Program**

The USHJA Outreach Program was established in 2022 to engage and connect hunter and jumper riders and horse owners with the USHJA by providing the opportunity to participate in USHJA branded classes and competitions, to earn points toward year-end rewards and awards, and to earn the chance to participate in the prestigious USHJA National Championships

SNHSA, an Affiliate organization of USHJA, joined the USHJA Outreach Program in mid-June of 2022. Points from SNHSA local shows are submitted to USHJA for members who have signed up for the Outreach Program. Points from other shows in the USHJA Outreach Program are also tabulated and members throughout the country participate in the Program. SNHSA is in USHJA's Zone 10.

13 SNHSA members were within the top 2023 50 overall in Zone 10: Jessica Abrams (4), Cadence Lacroix (5), MacLean Sennhenn, Sequoia Denton, Nicku Bruce, Gianna Calderoni, Sterling Sennhenn, Ava Christoferson, Nolan Garnett, Clara Blomeyer, Gracie Lee Henry, Hannah Hutter, and Ava Sabin. (By comparison, there were 5 SNHSA members in this list last year!)

All riders who have achieved 50 or more cumulative points will receive an email mid-January that has a link and will allow them to pick from ribbon, medallion, swag, or logowear for each medal level. There are different prizes for each level.

Any rider/horse with 100 or more points would be considered a Gold Level rider; Silver Level riders achieve 75-99 points, and Bronze Level riders achieve 50-74 points during the competition year. See the Zone 10 final list on the USHJA website.

SNHSA members should remember to sign up or renew their membership for the 2024 competition year. Remember, Outreach membership is free!

he SNHSA Hunter Team Challenge inaugural event took place Saturday, Sept. 16 at Franktown Meadows Equestrian Facility. Six teams competed for the the winning team prizes: a rider sash, embroidered cooler and ribbons to 8th place.

The 1st place Champion logo en team was "89451" with Nolan Garnett on Geppeto, MacLean Sennhenn on Franktown's Heavens Sake and Ava Sabin on Maitri.

Reserve Champions were "The High Tops" with Aubrey Smith on Just Send It, Clara Blomeyer on Hardly Strictly, and Zoa Clayton on Huapongo.

The 3rd place team was "The Break Dancers" with Penelope Martinez on Rembrandt, Lillian Blomeyer on Delancey, and Jennifer Preman on Res.U.lution.

In 4th place was "Firing on Four Cylinders" with Sterling Sennhenn on Invinciblue, Hannah Hutter on Farmore Royal Gala, Caylin Garnett on Marvel and Allison King on Mr. Dior.

The 5th place team was "2 Maddies and a Tiffany" with Maddie Rosander on Baloubino, Maddie Rau on Mango and Tiffany Coury on Faradette S.

The 6th place team, "The Stars Align" had Aubrey Morrison on San Remo LS, Maddison Hodge on Pot of Gold, Lisa Petersen-Trujillo on Outspoken, and Hannah Nelson on Acclaimation B.

#### **Hunter Team Challenge Rules**

The SNHSA Hunter Team Challenge is modeled after the USHJA Hunter Team Challenge. Riders in the Team Challenge must be a SNHSA member in good standing, and horses must be registered for points to accrue.

Teams compete at four different fence heights: 18" (crossrails), 2'3", 2'6" and 2'9". Teams of four must have a horse/ rider combination competing at each fence height; teams of three must have horse/

riders compete at 3 different fence heights. Each team must declare a Team Coach.

Each horse may only compete on one team, and not more than one professional is allowed per team. The professional may not compete at the 18" crossrail fence height.

The Challenge consists of a single Hunt and Go Round and a single Under Saddle class. Riders will receive a numerical score 0-100 from both phases of the over-fences round (Classic and Handy) and for the under saddle class. All riders at a particular fence height will complete their round, fences will be adjusted to the next height, and all riders at that height will jump their round, etc. until all over-fences rounds have been completed.

The Under Saddle class will be separated by Walk/Trot riders, and Walk/Trot/Canter riders, with no more than 7 riders in the ring at a time. Riders will be assigned their under saddle class order of go after teams are registered.

Their Overall score will consist of 40% Classic score, 40% Handy score, and 20% from the under saddle round score.

Team scores are calculated by adding each team member's Overall scores. Four-member teams will drop their lowest Overall score. Three-member teams will drop their lowest Overall score and double their second lowest Overall score to ensure all teams have the benefit of a dropped score.

At the conclusion of under saddle round, scores will be tabulated and the winning team placings declared.

In 2024, teams will be drawn from entered horse/rider combinations.





**Nicku:** *Dinah was the quintessential pony schoolmaster.* Gentle on the ground and under saddle. Patient and even tempered. Tolerant and kind. She taught my boys how to ride. She took beautiful, careful care of them from paddock to arena back to paddock.

She comforted my two-month old orphan filly after her mama's passing and also accompanied her to her Westphalian inspection a few months later. Dinah was CERTAIN that the entire inspection event was just for HER and strutted around alongside my foal, stealing the show! She taught us how to get and KEEP a pure white horse clean.

And we'd be remiss not to thank her family, the Strahans, for sharing their beautiful, beloved pony with so many of us, so selflessly. Dinah deserves nothing less than this award for her contribution to all of us, and to the SNHSA community, she was a loving legend. We love and miss you beautiful girl.

Suzan: Over her long life (28 years) she took care of first my children, and then hundreds more probably. She was always that "worth her weight in gold" pony. I am sure you will recall her at many SNHSA competitions with tiny Amelia Brown, but those are only the tips of her long and varied show career that began in San Diego.

If I put a child on Dinah I never once worried for their safety, she was my partner in

teaching the Littles and the Best Pony Ever. You can ask Nic Bruce how she kept her sons safe, she has quite a story to tell. Miss Dinah even competed at the Sagebrush shows this year

with 3 different children and will be receiving some year-end awards, despite not being able to finish the season due to her Cushings and IR flaring up.

We lost her to the Rainbow Bridge this year on Aug. 8. I let as many parents know the afternoon before I had to put her down and they let more know. That evening she had so very many children come visit, love on her and say goodbye well until it was dark.
