Attention SNHSA members!

The 2023 SNHSA Rulebook changes and amendments has been updated and is available online. The links below will also access the change document and the 2023 Rulebook.

Updates to the 2023 season include:

- · Addition and clarification of USEF tests included in Mini Medal, Jr/AM Medal and Medal Finals classes
- · 2023 Board members and officers
- inclusion of electronic sports timer rental and responsibilities for show managers
- Clarifying that 3 venues must include a minimum of 2 different physical addresses
- update of horse/pony fees increase last season
- · addition of speed classes at SNHSA Benefit shows
- Exceptions to the Special Declaration Form rules for Speed classes at SNHSA Benefit shows
- · Addition of cross entry rules for Equitation Over Fence classes
- Clarification of the 3-venue rule for Divisions 4 & 5
