General Rules, Regulations & Information

RULES: US Equestrian and SNHSA guidelines will be followed. The decisions of the management and judges are final.

ENTRY FEES: All regular, no-money classes are \$40 if pre-entered by <u>8 p.m., Tuesday, July 4.</u> Post-registration pricing is \$10 more per class; warm-up rounds are \$40.

- A separate Registration form is required for the Friday AJA Equine show. Saturday and Sunday classes will be on the Pair of Aces Show Form.
- Entry fee for Low and High Hunter Derbies is \$50. The \$50 fee will be on the chosen Derby Handy Round class.
- Entry fee for the Jumper derbies #228 and #229 are \$75 each. Horses must be
 entered in at least 3 other classes to be eligible to enter jumper derbies. Derby
 riders must enter by NOON Saturday! After that time, if post-entries are accepted,
 riders will ride at the top of the order.
- Entry forms must be filled out completely on or before 8 p.m., July 4 to be considered pre-entered.
- Only email pre-entries will be accepted. Email to susanhhowe@gmail.com. If
 you do not receive a confirmation email, text Susan at 775-750-6475 to ask for
 confirmation. Your email registration will be late if not received due to emailing to
 the wrong email address.
- NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK or CASH.
- Management reserves the right to limit total number of entry registrations for a day or the weekend.

PAYMENTS:

- Please bring at least 2 checks, one for AJA Equine (for Friday classes), one for Pair of Aces Stables (for Saturday & Sunday classes, schooling and overnight stavs).
- For those who are not yet SNHSA members, SNHSA membership will require a separate check made to SNHSA.
- There will be a \$50 charge on all returned checks.

SNHSA FEES:

- There is a \$10 per horse, non-refundable horse fee required by SNHSA.
- A \$25 SNHSA non-member fee is required for non-member riders entering

SNHSA-sanctioned classes.

*Denotes classes not SNHSA-sanctioned, membership is not required and no year-end points accrue.

DOGS: SNHSA requires that dogs be on a leash at all sanctioned events. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors.

HORSE WELFARE: For the welfare of horses/ponies, a horse/pony may not enter and show in more than six (6) classes in a day.

CROSS ENTRIES: All cross-entry rules apply for classes entered. Please refer to the SNHSA Rule Book available online at www.SNHSA.org for a complete set of rules.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money will be paid 50%, 30%, and 20% in all money classes (stakes & derbies). Prize money will only be paid out if there are five (5) or more competing entries in a class. Ribbons to 6th place for all derbies.

OUTDOOR PIPE PANELS: A limited number of outdoor pipe panel pens are available for \$35/day or night. You are responsible for bringing your own water buckets, feeding and watering. Horses may arrive on Thursday at 10:00 am or later. Call Liz at (775) 220-2270 to reserve paddock space.

SCHOOLING: Schooling is available Thursday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., \$30/day/horse. Riders must have a signed and completed entry blank on file in the show office prior to schooling. (Reminder, please clean up any manure your horse has made!)

PROOF OF EHV VACCINATION: within the past 6 months is required. Digital proof is preferred. Please send to Susan Howe at susanhhowe@gmail.com with show registration forms.

NON-SHOWING FEE: Horses not entered in the show must complete an entry blank and pay a fee of \$30/day and must have a signed waiver on file in the show office prior to arrival

Derbies in General:

- · Horse/Rider combo may only enter one Derby per day.
- · Each horse may only enter one Derby per day.
- Riders may enter any number of horses in derbies, assuming all cross-entry restrictions are followed.

Jumper Derby - sponsored by Organized Storage Solutions: To be eligible, horses/ponies must enter and compete in at least 3 other classes. In the jumper derby, the horses/ponies and riders are judged under Table 2.2b. There will be a drawn posted order of go. **Attire:** Jumper formal attire with jacket is required for Jumper derbies. Special Declaration forms are needed for High Jumper Derby points.

Low and High Hunter Derby specs: First round of the division counts as Round 1 of the Hunter Derby. In the event of two divisions at the same height, rider must declare by the end of the day prior which round they will use as Round 1 of their Derby.

All Derby rounds to be judged under open scoring. Scores from Round 1 and the Handy Round will be combined to determine placings for each Derby. Derby Handy Round to run congruent with fence heights throughout the day. Award ceremony to be held immediately following the last Derby Handy Round of the Low Hunter Derby and the High Hunter Derby.

\$500 Low Hunter Derby - **sponsored by Cancer Care Specialists** - 18"-2'3" divisions include Jr/Am Crossrail, Mini Hunter and Long/Short Stirrup Hunters (306 with 308) or (choose 1 of 313, 315, 316 with 318).

\$500 High Hunter Derby - sponsored by Diamond B Equine - divisions include Special, Modified Child/AA, Low, Children's/AA and Open Modified Hunters (choose 323 or 325 with 327), (329 with 331), (338 with 340) (341 with 343)

Cloverleaf Medal 3': Open to Junior and Amateur riders not showing over 3'6" at the same show. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control over a jumper type

course. A tone will be used to signal the rider to start the course. Any jumper type bit or equipment is allowed. Work-off will be at the judge's discretion. At least three riders must enter and show for the class to count. First and second place qualify for the finals.

Almaden Farms Jr/Am Medal 2'9": Open to Junior and Amateur riders not showing over 3'3" at the same show. Five riders must enter for the class to count. The course must include a combination, two changes of direction, and two tests. First and second place qualify for the finals.

Madden Crossrail Medal Jr/Am 18": Course of eight (8) fences at 18" in height. Additional testing at judge's discretion. Open only to riders not showing over 18" at this show. All riders earning a ribbon in this class will be qualified for the finals. Qualifying period is from October 2022 to October 2023. Finals will be held at the Brookside Fall Finale in 2023 and the winner will earn a golf cart.

SNHSA Mini Medal: Rider and trainer must be SNHSA members. Open to Junior and Amateur riders not showing over 2'6" at the same show. Riders may not have competed in the SNHSA Jr/Am Medal Class within the preceding two years. To be shown over a course of no less than six obstacles, oxers may not exceed 18" in width, no solid jumps permitted. Two tests (1-9, 10 with a simple lead change only, 12-14 or 20) of the USEF rulebook are required during the first round. Two riders must enter and show for the class to count. The top eight (8) riders according to points up through the Medal Finals will qualify the rider for the Finals, to be held at Franktown Meadows Equestrian Facility on Sept. 16-17, 2023.

SNHSA Jr/Am Medal: Rider and trainer must be SNHSA members. Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Riders may not have competed in the SNHSA Mini Medal Class within the same year. Two or more tests (1-22) of the USEF are required of the top four (4) competitors. Two riders must enter and show for the class to count. The top eight (8) riders according to points up through the Medal Finals will qualify the rider for the Finals, to be held at Franktown Meadows Equestrian Facility on Sept. 16-17, 2023.


