The rescheduled 2022 SNHSA Medals Final Benefit Show will be held April 1 at Brownlee Equestrian.

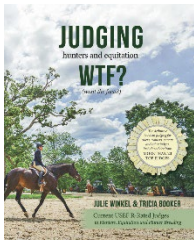
