SNHSA 2021 FINAL POINTS BULLETIN

The 2021 show season ended with the SNHSA Jumper Benefit & Medal Finals held Nov. 6 & 7 in conjunction with Ironwood Events Center's Show on Saturday, Nov. 6. There were 67 riders and 71 horses from eight barns, including two from California, as well as 4 independent riders, and many earned their final venue(s).

The 2021 end of the season points have been tabulated and this email serves as the Final Points Bulletin notice. Year-end award rules have been applied and the Year End column tally reflects those riders and horses who have completed three venues.

Year-End Award points Rules

SNHSA offers year-end awards in 26 divisions. Awards are presented to the top five placings in most divisions, with Gold, Silver or Bronze awards in the Walk/Trot division and Gold and Silver in the Beginner Rider Equitation division.

1. To be eligible for year-end awards in the Hunter or Jumper divisions, the horse must participate in three (3) different venues.

2. To be eligible for year-end awards in the Equitation division, the rider must participate in three (3) different venues

3. To be eligible for year-end awards in the Walk-Trot and Beginner Rider Equitation divisions, the qualifications are that the horse is registered (for those in Walk-Trot), the rider must be a SNHSA member and must participate in three (3) different venues. Criteria for year-end awards are based on points earned versus points available. The rider earns 1 point for every Walk-Trot or Beginner Rider Equitation class he/she completes.

Members are encouraged to keep their own point totals, as well as to check their point totals in each issue of the newsletter/points bulletin to make certain they are correct. Reports of suspected errors in the final points bulletin must be submitted in writing within 15 days of publication.

Due to the many show cancellations this season due to smoke and air quality issues, the SNHSA board voted to continue with the same amendments instituted during the 2020 season. The amendments for the 2021 season include the following:

10-Point Rule

The 10-point minimum requirement to qualify for year-end awards is suspended. **There will be no minimum points to be eligible for year-end awards this season.**

Walk/Trot and Beginner Rider Equitation

The required points for awards have been reduced. The following are the required points per Gold, Silver or Bronze Awards:

~ Walk/Trot Division: 8 Gold, 6 Silver, 3 Bronze

~ Beginner Rider Equitation Division: 5 Gold, 3 Silver

3-Venue Rule

The 3-venue rule stays in effect.

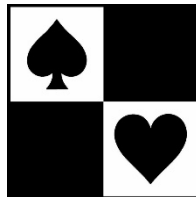
