2022 Year-End Award Points Bulletin



The 2022 show season ended with cancellation of the Hunter/Equitation and Medal Finals Benefit Show. To address the issue of a 3rd venue that some still needed, the Board voted to allow those who pre-registered for the (cancelled) Benefit show to receive their 3rd venue. This was a special situation where the Board worked to find a solution to a situation beyond members' control.

The 2022 end of the season points have been tabulated and this email serves as the Final Points Bulletin notice. Year-end award rules have been applied and the Year-End column tally reflects those riders and horses who have the five highest totals and have completed at least three venues.

Year-End Award points Rules

SNHSA offers year-end awards in 27 divisions. Awards are presented to the top five placings in most divisions, with Gold, Silver or Bronze awards in the Walk/Trot division and Gold and Silver in the Beginner Rider Equitation division.

1. To be eligible for year-end awards in the Hunter or Jumper divisions, the horse must participate in three (3) different venues.
2. To be eligible for year-end awards in the Equitation division, the rider must participate in three (3) different venues
3. To be eligible for year-end awards in the Walk-Trot and Beginner Rider Equitation divisions, the qualifications are that the horse is registered (for those in Walk-Trot), the rider must be a SNHSA member and must participate in three (3) different venues. Criteria for year-end awards are based on points earned versus points available. The rider earns 1 point for every Walk-Trot or Beginner Rider Equitation class he/she completes.

Members are encouraged to keep their own point totals, as well as to check their point totals in each issue of the newsletter/points bulletin to make certain they are correct. Reports of suspected errors in the final points bulletin must be submitted in writing within 15 days of publication. (Discrepancies must be sent to Susan Howe at susanhhowe@gmail.com.)

2022 USHJA Outreach Program

SNHSA participates in The USHJA Outreach Program. Points were submitted starting with the June 11-12 Brownlee Eq show. If you signed up for the free USHJA Outreach membership, check your standings!

Each Zone (we are Zone 10) offers year-end awards at Gold, Silver and Bronze levels. Points accrue for USHJA Outreach in Equitation, Hunter and Jumper divisions, as follows. Note that this is a different point system than the SNHSA points system and will not affect SNHSA year-end points or awards.

1st place – 10 points, 2nd place – 6 points, 3rd place – 4 points, 4th place – 2 points, 5th place – 1 point, 6th place – ½ point

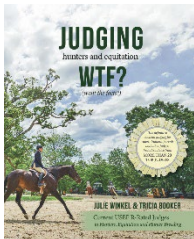
