



## 2014 SNHSA Rule Book Changes and Amendments

The following rule changes and revisions were approved by the SNHSA Board of Directors on Mar. 28, 2014, and are effective immediately. The changes have been made to the 2014 SNHSA Rule Book and Bylaws. To view the rule book in its entirety, please go to the SNHSA.org website.

### Summary of changes:

- In maintaining the welfare of the horse/pony, horses/ponies may not enter or show in more than six (6) classes in a day.
- Show managers: Show prize lists must include this statement: Horses/ponies may not enter or show in more than six classes in a day.
- A revision has been made to Article VII. D. Division Descriptions & Specifications.
  1. Division 7 – Mini-Hunters: Changed fence height back to 2' to 2'3".

The actual Rule Book changes are detailed below with changes highlighted in yellow:

### Article IV

#### I. Welfare of the Horse

1. For the welfare of the horse/pony, horses/ponies may not enter and show in more than six (6) classes in a day.

### Article V

#### B. Welfare of the Horse

10. The show's prize list must include this statement: *Horses/ponies may not enter and show in more than six (6) classes in a day.*

#### D. Division Descriptions & Specifications

##### Division 7 - Mini Hunters – 2' to 2'3" Open

Rider must be a SNHSA member and horse/pony must be registered with SNHSA in order for points to accrue for year-end awards. To be judged on performance, soundness and manners. Extreme speed will be penalized. To be shown over a course of fences 2' to 2'3". Horse/rider combination may not cross enter over 2'6" at the same show.
