With 9 shows for the 2021 season, each person could earn 9 raffle chances from show evaluations. A completed 2021 General Satisfaction Survey will also earn a person one chance. USHJA NATIONAL NEWS

2021 USHJA Nationals - Nov. 15-21, 2021

The **AON/USHJA National Championships** are set to return in 2021 at The Las Vegas National, CSI4*-W, in Las Vegas, NV, Nov. 15-21.

The Championships will feature the USHJA Affiliate Championships for Junior and Adult Amateur riders in 8 divisions and 3 disciplines, along with many other National Hunter and Jumper Championships. Classes offered this year are:

- **Hunters 2' and 2'6"**
- **Equitation at 2' (14 & under) and 2'6" (ages 15-17 and 18 & over)**
- **Jumpers at 0.70m, 0.80m, 0.90m**

As a USHJA Affiliate Organization, SNHSA will choose our most qualified horse and rider combinations for each division to nominate in 2021! Affiliate organizations are invited to select three riders for each section in order of preference, with the #1 rider guaranteed a spot. Riders #2 and #3 are not guaranteed entry as only 30 entries are accepted per section. **HORSE & RIDER combinations may not cross enter into the Rated Championship divisions.**

SNHSA will be offering sponsorships but the guidelines have not yet been determined for this year's competition.

To be considered as a nominee for the USHJA Affiliate Championships, each horse/rider combination, their parent/guardian (if the rider is under 18 years of age) and their trainer will need to submit a Declaration of Intent form (not yet finalized) along with a \$25 payment. The **\$25 fee will secure the horse/rider combination's declaration of intent.**

As a part of SNHSA's selection process, the performance of horse/rider combinations in the following SNHSA divisions will be included in their final selection criteria.

- 2' Hunter USHJA Affiliate section: Long/Short Stirrup 2' and Mini Hunter 2'-2'3"
- 2'6" Hunter USHJA Affiliate section: Special Hunter 2'3"-2'6" and Modified Child/Adult Hunter 2'3"-2'6"
- 2' Equitation 14 & Under USHJA Affiliate section: Equitation 13 & Under, Equitation 14-17 (flat and over fences)
- 2'6" Equitation 15-17 USHJA Affiliate section: Equitation 14-17 (flat and over fences)
- 2'6" Equitation 18 & Over USHJA Affiliate section: Equitation 18 & Over (flat and over fences)
- 0.70m Jumper USHJA Affiliate section: Kindergarten and Puddle Jumpers
- 0.80m Jumper USHJA Affiliate section: Pre-Training Jumpers
- 0.90m Jumper USHJA Affiliate section: Level 1 and Low Child/Adult Jumpers
