June 28 - 30, 2019 marked the 8th Annual Meadow View Farms Charity Horse Show, benefiting Northern Nevada Children's Cancer Foundation. The inaugural show, in 2012, put together with the help of some of our clients, was a one-day show that raised \$10,000. Eight years later, we have the support of the larger community; now a three-day format, the show has raised over \$300,000 for the local charity. With classes from Walk-Trot to 1.20m Jumpers, and a Jumper Team Relay, Jumper Derby and Hunter Derby, there is something for everyone, exhibitors and spectators alike. Horses and their riders came out to raise money for the Northern Nevada Children's Cancer Foundation, and the accounting team is working diligently...
