Do you want to hear from the judges of this year's Interscholastic Equestrian Association National Championships as well as the USEF Pony Finals and USHJA International Hunter Derby Championships? This is an educational and fun workshop based on the book by the same name by Julie Winkel and Tricia Booker. This two day clinic takes the mystery of our judging Hunters and Equitation and allows you to understand step-by-step the processes involved in evaluating and scoring jumping, under saddle and conformation classes.

In addition to the facts, you'll hear first-hand accounts and stories from two judges with a combined 60+ years in the judge's box. You'll learn how judges keep their cards and the process of scoring and take part in live judging of conformation, under saddle and jumping classes. After attending the clinic, you'll never look at judging the same again while becoming a savvy competitor in the show ring!

Workshop attendees will receive a signed copy of the Judging Hunters and Equitation WTF? (Want The Facts?) book. A discount on the purchase of the book will also be offered to workshop participants.

This clinic, which benefits the Goodstocknow Horses 501(c)(3), may be tax deductible. It's open to auditors, riders, trainers, parents, judges and anyone interested in learning more about judging and the processes involved, from ethics and integrity to bookkeeping, rules and licensing.

2022 USHJA OUTREACH PROGRAM



2022 USHJA Outreach Program

SNHSA has chosen to participate in The USHJA Outreach Program, and our local shows will now be recognized by USHJA in their outreach program! We have submitted points from the June 11-12 Brownlee Eq show, Franktown Meadows Hunter Derby, AJA Equine, SNHSA Jumper Division Benefit and the Ironwood Events Center shows. If you are a USHJA Outreach member and

have your horse registered, you are already receiving points! If you haven't signed up for USHJA Outreach membership (free) and horse registration, then do so now!

Each Zone (we are Zone 10) will offer year-end awards at Gold, Silver and Bronze levels. Points accrue for USHJA Outreach in Equitation, Hunter and Jumper divisions, as follows. Note that this is a different point system than the SNHSA points system and will not affect SNHSA year-end points or awards.

1st place – 10 points, 2nd place – 6 points, 3rd place – 4 points, 4th place – 2 points, 5th place – 1 point, 6th place – ½ point

What should you do:

1. Compete in classes at local SNHSA shows.
2. Become an Outreach member (or higher) on or before the first day of competition to accrue rider points. **Membership is free. See links below**
3. Register your horse with USHJA for points to be tracked. To become a member of the Outreach Program, Horse Registration is \$20 for an Annual Recording, or \$75 for a Lifetime Recording. **See links below.**

SNHSA has raised its horse fee to \$10 to cover show fees and expense per horse that USHJA requires to administer the program regardless of individual SNHSA OR USHJA member participation.

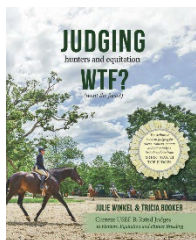
