## USHJA NATIONAL NOMINEES ANNOUNCED

### 2021 USHJA Nationals - Nov. 15-21, 2021

The USHJA National Championships will be held Nov. 15-21 at The Las Vegas National, CSI4\*-W, in Las Vegas, NV. The Championships will feature the USHJA Affiliate Championships for Junior and Adult Amateur riders in 11 divisions and 3 disciplines, along with many other National Hunter and Jumper Championships. As an Affiliate Member organization, SNHSA is invited to send its top three rider/horse combinations to apply and compete at Nationals!

**Congratulations** to the 18 SNHSA members who declared their intentions to compete at nationals and were chosen by the SNHSA Board of Directors to compete in the following sections. Riders will receive \$200 per section upon confirmation of registration acceptance. First-place nominees are guaranteed a spot in the competition. Second- and third-place rider/horse combinations will have the opportunity to fill a 30 horse/rider field in each section. Fourth place rider/horse combinations are listed as alternates should one of the 1st-3rd place riders not be able to go.

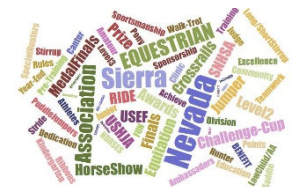
