



Northern Nevada Horse and Fire Fund

Sierra Nevada Horse Show Association (SNHSA) has created the Northern Nevada Horse and Fire Fund in recognition that the severity and frequency of wildfires in our region have resulted in catastrophic consequences. Wildfire season now occurs 12 months of the year, threatening property, animal and human lives and livelihoods.

This enduring fund will have a two-fold mission:

- The first priority will be to provide immediate relief and support to community members affected by fires in Northern Nevada. The funds will be used for health and human services, short-term housing/rental assistance, reimbursement of equipment and supplies, and other immediate relief for affected individuals.
- The second initiative of the fund is to develop and distribute a “fire safety” strategy specifically for Northern Nevada community members who own horses. This strategy plans to address important topics such as best practices to make your property “fire safe,” recommended evacuation plans for animals, as well as a coordinated community plan identifying interim places where displaced horses can stay.

This fund is a trusted repository for philanthropic assets to be directed for these two purposes.
